How to Enter

Submit a proposal which should be no longer than 1200 words in total including:

- A short biography (Max 200 words)
- Summary of the conference/event you wish to attend and why this is relevant (Max 200 words)
- What you expect to gain (Max 150 words)
- How your visit will enhance learning in the field of effective practice in community/ public health nutrition and how you will share this with the CNG membership (Max 150 words)
- Breakdown of how you propose the money will be spent (Max 500 words)
- Please attach full details of the conference you plan to attend

The Outcome

The winner will be notified by the end of April 2010. By applying for the award, you are committing to*:

- Attend the conference as detailed in your proposal
- Collect evidence of your learning experience and its impact on your practice
- Present your submission at a CNG meeting in 2010, if requested
- Report on your findings at a CNG meeting in 2011
- Produce a report for the CNG website & an article for our newsletter
- To keep CNG informed of your contact details until 2013
- To remain a member of CNG until April 2013

*Members need to ensure they have appropriate insurance cover as, if due to so that in unforeseen circumstances they are unable to attend CNG will request reimbursement of all costs
